This cake was my mom's recipe. This cake can be made either Chocolate or Spice.

1 ¼ C. Hot coffee

Pour over 1 C. oatmeal.

½ C butter

1 C. Brown Sugar

1 C. White sugar

Mix the above ingredients thoroughly.

2 eggs add and beat well.

1 ½ C. Flour

1 tsp. Soda

½ tsp. salt

Add and stir in

2 sq. Melted chocolate, add beat well. (omit chocolate foe spice cake)

1 tsp. Cinnamon

½ tsp. Nutmeg. (omit spices for chocolate cake)

Put in greased and floured pan.

Bake at 350 for 30 minutes or center is done.

Hope you enjoy this cake. You can just eat it as is or sprinkle powdered sugar over top to dress it up.
