PRUNE, APPLE OR CHERRY CAKE

Mix together:

½ c. sugar

1 c. flour

1 tsp. baking powder

½ tsp salt

Add:

2 Tbsp shortening (butter)

1 egg

½ c. milk

Spread batter into lightly greased pan, place fruit on top of batter, as desired,

Sprinkle with 1 cup sugar (depending upon sweetness of fruit) and bake for

About 1 hour at 350.

The above recipe makes a small cake , about 9 x 12, or 8" square pan works well,
